


Tuck shop

I'd like to thank parents for supporting the school tuck shop. Without this scheme school would not be able to continue with the £10 cap on school trips. I'd like to reassure all parents that the food on offer is healthy and tasty. Children have the opportunity to purchase a variety of cereal bars, brioche rolls, croissants, fresh fruit, dry fruit, popcorn, yogurts or breakfast biscuits and also receive a drink. The items are rotated so children receive a good balance during the week.

Unfortunately some children do come to school with little or no breakfast; the KS2 tuck shop helps to fight off the hunger pangs until lunchtime. We have up to 60 children using the tuck shop each day.

If parents do not want children to partake in the tuck shop then please send your child with a piece of fruit as children do get hungry mid-morning.

Parents Evenings will be held 4pm-6pm on:


- Tuesday 3rd November
