


Message from the Headteacher

Parents Meetings

It was great to see so many of our parents attend the meetings last week. The teachers try very hard to keep parents updated regularly about their children's attainment and progress. Unlike other schools our teachers produce three reports for parents; most schools only give one end of year report. Our staff understand and appreciate the efforts our parents put in with their children and believe whole heartedly in this partnership and therefore do go the extra mile with the children. Parents are given a ten minute slot and sometimes our teachers do run over and I'd like to thank parents for their patience with this.

Parent's that I spoke to now understand how the colour banded system works and what their child needs to do to move to the next stage in their learning. As we continue to evolve our assessment practices, we will now assess children at the end of every ½ term. If we find that your child has not made the required progress then we will either invite parents in or provide additional support for your child in class. If we do not get in touch with you that means your child is doing well.

The homework projects that the children are producing at the moment are better than ever. As Headteacher this shows me that children are engaging with their learning beyond the parameters of the school gates and also that parents are spending quality time with their children working and learning together. I have worked in many schools in Bradford and Kirklees and haven't come across such commitment from parents who truly believe that we can Exceed Expectations!
