Support to victims of domestic violence and abuse, sexual violence, 'honour' based violence, forced marriage and female genital mutilation.

Refuge/Safe Accommodation

Huddersfield Women's Aid (HWA)

Provides temporary emergency accommodation to women with or without children who are victims of domestic abuse.

Kirklees Asian and Black Women's Welfare Association (KABWWA)

Provides specialist temporary emergency accommodation to women with or without children from black minority ethnic communities who are victims of domestic abuse.

Live Safe Hub Community Based Outreach Services

Sanctuary Scheme (SS)

Supports victims of domestic abuse, who are no longer in a relationship with the perpetrator, to remain in their own property by:

- Installing security measures in the victim's property.
- Providing one to one crisis intervention support for up to 8 weeks.

Staying Safe in Kirklees (SSIK)

Supports victims of domestic abuse with an emphasis on early intervention and safety planning to prevent escalation of risk. SSIK provides one to one support up to 3 months.
