



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Welcome back after the holidays – the children appear well rested, happy and excited about the plans we have for this half term.

On Thursday 2nd March we will be celebrating World Book Day – as always, classrooms will be decorated in accordance to the book that the teachers have selected for WBD. Events for the day will be captured and put on the school website, Parent Hub and Twitter.



On Wednesday 9th March, we will be joined by D Dance Theatre CIC. The children will all take part in a dance/movement activity with a trained professional, Chiragi Solanki. Members from the dance troop are quite unique as the ladies who take part are retired professionals from the Oulton Hall area. We would like to create a fusion of young and old, diverse communities, languages, beliefs and cultures. The hall will be out of use on this day so children will be provided with dinner in their classrooms. Year 5 and 6 school council representatives will have lunch with the ladies. We are expecting some publicity for this event and I am keen to demonstrate our acceptance and involvement in the wider community.



Parents' evening will take place the week beginning 21st March, for most classes. A message will be sent out on Parent Hub- please book you preferred time ASAP to avoid disappointment. The school will be carrying out a parent questionnaire – please look out for this on Parent Hub. Please spend time completing the survey as we appreciate parent's comments and work hard to ensure we meet your expectations. We want to hear how we can improve the school further but would also like to hear your thoughts on all that's great about Warwick Road. Our staff work hard for the children at our school and their caring approach ensures children are well-equipped to learn.

On 22nd March, we have booked for the school photographer to come into school and take pictures for our school website. If there is anything you feel that the children should be pictured taking part in for the school website, then please let us know.



Monitoring showed that an area for school to make improvements in was lunchtimes. The school have employed a Learning Mentor, Miss Robinson, who joined us last half term. She comes to us with a wealth of experience and is thoroughly enjoying working with our amazing children. She has re-vamped our lunchtimes and I am hoping that children have relayed the positive changes to parents. Future plans for lunchtimes/playtimes include creating a wellbeing garden (a bid has been submitted to fund this project). This area will become a quiet haven for children who like reading and enjoy being outdoors. Classes will all be given planters and we are hoping for the Wellbeing Garden to become an oasis of colour.



We have a member of staff who is a trained ELSA (emotional literacy support assistant). Since the pandemic, we have noted a number of children requiring support to deal with bereavement and dysregulated emotional behaviours. If you feel your child is in need of some emotional support, please do not hesitate to get in touch.

During the holidays, we will be running the HAF (Holiday Activities and Food programme) from Warwick Road School. Sessions will run from Monday 11th April to Thursday 14th April, then from Tuesday 19th April to Friday 22nd April. The sessions will run for 4 hours per day and food will be provided (timings and further details to follow whether this will be a meal or a snack). A flyer with further details will be sent out in the next few weeks. Please note, booking will be on a first come, first served basis and other schools in the locality will also be offered the use of our facility, so please book on as soon as the offer becomes available. The HAF programme coordinators are looking for caterers (must be registered) to provide the snacks/meals for the children during the holidays.
